**Purpose:** To deliver gymnastics and dance sessions within the day to day sports development programme. This to include, planning, monitoring and evaluation of sessions and activities. Maintain and enhance the quality and support growth of the provision.

**Responsible to:** Sports Development Manager/Premier League Primary Stars Lead

#### Duties:

- To deliver gymnastics and dance based PE and School Sport sessions in line with Ofsted framework and Albion Foundation's high quality standards
- Perform administration duties to support programmes, for example updating VIEWS with attendance information, distribution of information to schools and other organisations.
- Develop the Teacher CPD offer as part of The Albion Foundation's Premier League Primary Stars Programme with specialism in gymnastics and dance teaching
- Ensure all provision is delivered in a safe environment and all safeguarding regulations are followed.
- Ensure all equipment is prepared and suitable for each session, this includes first aid kits.
- Promote a positive and professional image at all times.
- Liaise with parents/carers, schools and teachers and other outside agencies, including our Dance organisation partner, Epic Dance Academy.
- Any other duties deemed appropriate by Sports Development Manager or equivalent.
